The simplest way to load Spellmaster from the disc is to use SHIFT-BREAK, which will automatically load the module into memory.

Another way to load it, which might be more useful if there is an application currently running, is to use the command *EXEC !LOADSPELL. However, if there is an application currently running there must be at least 124K of memory available in the relocatable module area for this method to work.

RISCOS Operating System

An application directory, called !Spell, is provided to load Spellmaster under the RISCOS desktop. Spellmaster is started by double clicking on the !Spell icon.

The version of Spellmaster loaded by this method is designed to work with the RISCOS version of Inter-Word and the 65Tube Emulator. If the Arthur version of Inter-Word and the 65Arthur emulator is being used then the Arthur loading sequence should be followed.
