

# *Cyber Chess* on the Risc PC

There can be problems with *Cyber Chess* on the Risc PC. It is a problem with loading the program from disc – the program runs fine once loaded.

If you experience problems loading *Cyber Chess*, reset your computer while holding down the Shift key. This will prevent the *Boot* file on your hard disc from being run on start up. Note that this also disables the virus protection, and so you should not insert any other discs than the *Cyber Chess* disc before you reset the computer again.

The computer should then load *Cyber Chess* with no problems.

You can copy *Cyber Chess* to your hard disc. However, due to the copy protection on the disc, it will still need the original program disc to be in the floppy drive when it is run. Again, this can cause problems on the Risc PC, and the solution is to reset your machine with the Shift key held down before running *Cyber Chess*.
